## Learning Overviews

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**Ladybirds** - This week they have been reading the story of Goldilocks and the 3 Bears. They have also read the story of Mr Wolf's Pancakes and wrote a sentence about the story. Also they tasted Pancakes on Tuesday and they were delicious. The sounds they have been learning this week are 'ay' and 'air'.

**Bumblebees** - In Maths this week they have been doing number bonds to 20. For Literacy they have been making predictions from pictures about what will happen in the true story of the 'Three Little Pigs'. In Science they have been using Lego looking at who invented it and Lego therapy. For their current Topic they have been doing a timeline on significant individuals. They have also designed a house for the 'Three Little Pigs'.

**Dragonflies** - What an exciting week they have had this week. They came in and became princes and princesses and decorated crowns as part of their new topic Kings and Queens. They have read a funny book called 'The Queen's Knickers' and have sequenced the events in the story and started to write what happened in the story. In Maths they have looked at 2D shapes and their properties and have learnt how to draw 2D shapes and how to recognise lines of symmetry.



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
