Learning Overviews

Ladybirds - This week in Phonics they have recapped all the sounds they have learnt and focused on blending 3 sounds to read CVC words. They have done a drawing/writing about their Christmas break. For Maths they have been focusing on representing numbers. The new topic is Polar regions and they have discussed what it may be like in the Polar regions. They created a Polar Bear at the creative table.

Bumblebees - For maths this week they have been counting in 2's, 5's and 10's and also they have introduced height into their learning who is shorter/taller. In Literacy they have been listing items to take to the moon and introduced the book "Whatever Next". For Topic it has been Geography comparing towns with the countryside. In Art they have been looking at the technique of shading and day to night.

Dragonflies - This week they have been looking at the 2, 5 and 10 times tables answering word problems involving times tables. For Literacy they have been looking at poems, the rhyming words and made a list of rhyming words. Next week they will be creating their own rhyming poem around winter. In Science they looked at what animals are suited to different habitats. For Topic they used iPad's to research facts about London and Australia. The children found lots of interesting facts which they can use in their topic work over the coming weeks.
