Learning Overviews

Ladybirds - This week they have had a healthy eating week. They made orange juice and did vegetable printing. In Maths they have really enjoyed their focus on matching, matching colours, objects and understanding 'same' and 'difference'.

Bumblebees - This week they have been looking 1 more and 1 less in Maths and equal to (inequality signs). For Literacy they have role-played the story Funnybones. For Phonics they have looked at the sounds 'sh', 'ch', 'ck', 'ff' and 'ss'. In science they have made a recipe for a human body. For topic they have forecasted the weather by doing role play. In RE they have put into order the creation story and then finally in PE they were doing dance routines.

Dragonflies - This week they have been super excited to move classrooms which means that they have more room to do learning. They have started a new book 'On the Way Home' by Jill Murphy. They made predictions about what the story was about and read the beginning of the book. For Maths they have looked at ordering and comparing numbers up to 100. They have started a geography topic of the local area and looked at different maps of the school which was very exciting. It was healthy eating week so they made posters about what foods are healthy to put up around the school
