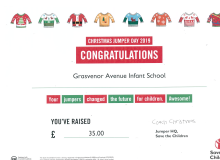
Dragonflies Trip to Lincolnsfield

Learning Overviews

Ladybirds - This week they have created a tricky word tree to help them with their writing. They have added two quantities together to find out how many they have altogether. Also they have been working really hard with their phonics and learnt the 'oo' sound in book, cook, took and look. Also the 'oo' sound in words like zoo, moon and soon.

Bumblebees - This week in Literacy they have been diary writing using a checklist. For Maths they have been measuring volume / capacity using non standard units. In Art they have been drawing from a point of different perspective. For Topic they have been continuing with directional language like captains coming. In Science they have been comparing two different animal bodies.

Dragonflies - This week they have looked at equivalent fractions e.g. $\frac{2}{4} = \frac{1}{2}$. They have started to look at statistics by creating a tally chart of their favourite colours in the class. They then created a pictograph from the same information before answering questions on which colour was the most popular and what the difference between each amount was. In Literacy we received an email from Noah in Australia telling them about his life in Australia and how he spent his holidays. They looked at what conjunctions they can use to compare their holidays to Noah's. In History they continued to compare physical and human features.
