Learning Overviews

Ladybirds - This week they celebrated Science week by planting broad beans, making slime and predicting which surface the car would travel down the fastest. They have started to read Jack and the Beanstalk. For Literacy they have been learning the oy sound. They have learnt about 3D shapes and used them in their construction activities.

Bumblebees - In Maths they have been doing subtraction within 20. For Literacy they have been hot seating doing a Q and A session about the Wolf and the Third Little Pig. For Science week they have been looking at the Greenhouse effect, Climate change and about the sea level rising. Also this week they have been doing some planting with Marks dad James of potatoes, strawberries and onions. In PE they have been doing team games.

Dragonflies - This week they have looked at 3D shapes and their properties. They investigated how they could make them using materials around them. For Literacy they started to look at the features of biographies in preparation to write a biography about Queen Elizabeth 11. They have looked up the meanings of unfamiliar words in a dictionary so they knew what they meant. For Science they made their own ice cream and tasted it, great fun was had throwing the ice cream around to make it freeze with the help of ice cubes. They investigated what makes an object sink or float and made their own aluminium boats to test their theories. One the

favourite experiments was making phone cups and seeing how sound travels through the air. They have been practising spelling common exception words which were given to all the Parents during Parents evening.
