Learning Overviews

Ladybirds - This week in Maths they have been doing weighing and have used words like heavier and lighter. For phonics they have recapped 'air', 'ear', 'igh' and 'ure'. They have been exploring the primary colours by painting different vehicles. They also had a music session where they were doing Nursery Rhymes with instruments.

Bumblebees - In Science this week they have been doing a seed diary, writing instructions on how to plant a seed and what equipment was needed. For Topic they have done a Transport survey looking at how they all travel to school. In Art they have been life drawing different plants. For Maths they have done a consolidation of their learning of place values to 50 and also addition and subtraction. In Literacy they have been writing about the holidays. Finally this week they have tried a Phonics screening test paper.

Dragonflies - This week they have been punctuating different sentence types and looked at how they know the differences between the different sentence types. In Science they have looked at seasons and what is different between each season and reasons why they are different. For Maths they have started to tell the time to the nearest five minutes. It would be helpful if they can practice this at home.
