Learning Overviews

Ladybirds - This week in Maths they have made their own rulers with their hands to measure items in the classroom. They had a music session using different objects to make sounds of dinosaurs. For Literacy this week they wrote about the life cycle of a frog. At the beginning of the week they planted some cress seeds and have been observing how they

are growing.

Bumblebees - In Science this week they have been looking at the parts of a tree and labelled them. In Art they went to the park and drew pictures of the different trees. For Maths they have been describing position like the square is on the left of the triangle. They have also been looking at money and recognising coins. In Literacy they have created a story board of the story 'The Tiny Seed' by Eric Carle. For PHSE they have done the five finger friendship challenge by writing five things that make them a good friend.

Dragonflies - This week they have created a storyboard about the 'Runaway Train' and used it to help them retell the story. They have looked at durations of time in maths and ordered those durations. Also they have looked at what it means to be a good friend and why being a good friend is important. For Geography they have looked at the climates in the Arctic and Antarctica and how they are the same and different.
